

NSW JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS DRAW 2023 EXPLANATORY NOTES 11's to 17's

Our aim to ensure teams will play at least 6 round games. Below is the explanation of how each division will work over the weekend.

Divisions with two pools of 6 teams will play a crossover ballot game then each team once in their pool. 6 games (the crossover ballot draw was recorded & kept for transparency)

Divisions with a pool/s of 7 will play each team in their pool once. 6 games

Divisions with 8 & 9 teams will play 6 games. The rounds selected have been based on a six game template draw. The template is an attachment with this document. Firstly, the teams were seeded into the pools based on last year's results. Then the team position within the pool was based on a ballot draw. This ballot draw is the fairest way to position the teams using the 6 game template. (The ballot position draw was recorded and kept for transparency)

Progression to Finals

Divisions with 2 pools.

Top 4 teams in each pool advance to the Quarter Finals. 1st A v 4th B, 2nd A v 3rd B etc. SF. GF.

Divisions with 3 pools.

Top 2 teams in each pool & the next best 2 of the thirds.

Teams are seeded 1 to 4, 5 to 8 for the Quarter Finals 1st v 8th, 2nd v 7th etc.

Divisions with 4 pools.

Top 2 teams in each pool.

Teams are seeded 1 to 4, 5 to 8 for the Quarter Finals 1st v 8th, 2nd v 7th etc.
