5. Player Qualification

5.1 To qualify for this tournament you must have played in the 2024 Regional tournament in the right division.

5.2 To meet the requirements the team that qualifies must have 8 players from the regional tournament.

5.3 Teams/players applying for dispensation must put a request in to jordan@oztag.com.au to be approved.

6. Team Numbers

6.1 Each team can play a maximum of 16 players, all to be included on the registration form.

8. Entry Fees

8.1 There is no entry fee for the CoC Tournament

9. Playing Uniform and Equipment

9.1 All Students must wear a school jersey with a number.

9.2 All students must wear Official Oztag Shorts manufactured by Oztag Equipment Supplies or former Oztag Merchandise. <u>There are NO Belts to be worn</u>

9.4 No League Tag or Tag20 shorts are to be worn. If there is a breach of the policy the team will forfeit all rights to participate.
