General Information

The intent of this event is twofold:

- To provide representative teams an opportunity to play a number of games on a single day in preparation for the 2022 State Cup.
- **To raise funds to support the Wells/Steele family**

There will be no ladders kept, nor will there be any finals played. This gala day is an opportunity to fine tune teams for State Cup. Penrith Oztag may make changes to the operation of the event, including any of these Conditions of Entry, on the day of the event in order to ensure the smooth operation of the event

Divisions

Men's Opens, Ladies Opens, Mixed Opens, Women's 40's+, Men's 40's +

Games

Each team is guaranteed 5 games. Games will commence at 8.30am and be 30 minutes in duration. There will be no halftime and teams will switch ends when a try is scored. The draw will be provided by 9th May 2022.

Entry Fee

\$200 per team (of up to 16 players). Teams can have more than 16 players but each additional player is an **extra \$20**. Minimum payment of \$200 must be made when team is entered.

Players

All players **MUST BE** currently registered OzTag players. Players may play in more than one team in different divisions (eg: Men's and Mixed) – players **MUST** be listed on each teams entry forms **PRIOR** to the day. Players **MUST** be listed on the registration sheet **PRIOR** to the day commencing. No guarantees will be given on games not clashing for players playing in more than one team.

There may be limits on the number of teams that we accept so entries will be accepted on a first come, first entered providing that all money is paid, and the team entry form is fully complete. Any team entered without full payment, or an uncompleted entry form is not considered to be entered until both are done.

Uniforms

All teams must be attired in a correct OzTag uniform meeting AOSA requirements

Rules

The event will be conducted under AOSA tournament rules. Jamie Howard is the Tournament Director and his decision is final in all tournament matters.

Judiciary

Any send offs will be reviewed by Tournament Director who will either issue a suspension from the tournament or refer it to the Penrith OzTag Association Judiciary who will decide if further action is warranted. Two POT's or a send off in a game will result in an automatic non appealable 1 game suspension.

Behaviour

Any unacceptable behaviour whilst attending the event will be met with severe repercussions.

Referee's

- Any people interested in refereeing are asked to contact **Jamie Howard** on **0413784443**. Referees will be paid \$20 per game. Please keep in mind this is a fund raiser day and we appreciate any and all support.
- Each team is to supply a referee who will be available to referee a game at the alternate timeslot to their team. This is non-negotiable. While we will endeavour to supply official referee's if we are unable to cover all games, team supplied referee's MUST be available to referee when requested.
- If a referee is required, their name will be drawn from a hat to determine who referee's.
- If a team does not supply a referee when they are requested that team will be withdrawn from any further games.
- Referees are not to be approached at any time by a coach, manager or parent unless your intention is to shake hands at fulltime and have something positive to say.
- Complaints re referee's should be directed solely to the Tournament Director not the referee.
- If clarification is sought re a rule the coach should approach the Tournament Director
- Teams must be at the field ready to play at least 5 minutes prior to the end of the last game. Games will run strictly to the allocated times of the draw.
- Any person who verbally abuses a referee or yells at the referee with comments which are unacceptable or not in the true spirit of the game will be asked to leave the venue. Failure to do so will see the team that person is associated with removed from the competition.

Game Start

- Teams require 5 players to start the game. The referee will whistle the start of the game after hearing the siren.
- If a Team is on the field and ready at the kick off whistle and the opposition is not ready the team will be penalised three (3) tries. Teams not ready to commence play within 2 minutes of the start siren will forfeit the game.

Smoking

The Kingsway is a smoke free facility and is governed by council regulation. This includes normal tobacco products and vape devices.

Wet Weather

Wet weather may result in the event being postponed or cancelled. If the event cannot be held on this day full refunds will be issued to all teams.
