## AUSTRALIAN OZTAG JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS DRAW 2023 EXPLANATORY NOTES

Our aim is to ensure teams play at least 6 round games.
Below is the explanation of how each division will work over the weekend.
We use a 6 game draw template. Template is attached with this document.
It doesn't matter if you have 8, 9, 10, 11 teams in a division all teams get 6 games.
To make the draw fair, as there is obviously some teams you will not play, a ballot draw is conducted for the teams position within the division. The ballots have been recorded for transparency and can be viewed if a coach feels the need to have a look. They can attend the admin office at the tournament to view it.

Divisions or pools with 8 to 11 teams will use the 6 game template draw with the exception of the girls 9 's. They have a pool of 8 teams so they will play each other once giving them 7 games. 4 teams will finish at this point and the other 4 will advance to the SF.

Divisions with 7 teams will play each team once.
Divisions with 12 teams will separate into two pools of 6 . First game will be a ballot crossover draw, also recorded, then play each team in the pool. 6 games.

FINALS
All divisions with 9 or more teams will play quarter finals. $1^{\text {st }} \vee 8^{\text {th }}, 2^{\text {nd }} \vee 7^{\text {th }}$ etc.
Divisions with two pools will play $1^{\text {st }} A \vee 4^{\text {th }} B, 2^{\text {nd }} A \vee 3^{\text {rd }} B$ etc
Divisions with 8 teams or less will play semi finals. $1^{\text {st }} v 4^{\text {th }}, 2^{\text {nd }} v 3^{\text {rd }}$.
QF, SF will be capped at 5 minutes extra time, drop off 5 players, golden try with right of reply
GF capped at 10 minutes.
