Playing Uniforms and Playing Equipment

No League Tag or Tag20 Shorts are to be worn this is to ensure consistency of the game. **If there is a breach of this policy the team will forfeit all rights to participate.**

Team squad numbers

Teams can register a maximum of 12 players and a minimum of 8. A maximum of 12 players can play during any game.

Team Registration

Please fill out attached team registration form and return via email by Thursday the 30th of January.

Insurance

All players at this tournament will be registered under the regular Australian Oztag insurance policy for tournaments.

Photography

Our official Oztag Photographer will be there taking photos & videos. If a player does not want his/her photograph taken please notify prior to competition.

Age Qualification

Players must be 15 years of age or older before the tournament.

Game Play

Round Games will be 8 Minutes Halves with a 2-minute half time break. All teams will play a minimum of 4 games.

Finals

There will be NO extra time Semi Finals. In the event of a draw the Highest



Qualifying team will progress to Grand Final.

Grand Finals

Extra time will occur in Grand Finals if at the end of play the score is tied. There will be 5 minutes each way, Drop Off to 5 players NO INTERCHANGE, GOLDEN POINT. A right of reply will be in play – e.g. If team A scores in the first set, Team B has the right to an attacking set. If Team A defends the set out, they win.

Explanatory Notes

Mens

- 7 Teams in one Pool will play 5 rounds.
- All teams will play a minimum of 4 round games
- Finals will be decided on strike rate as some teams will play 5 games, others will play 4 and have a bye.
- Top 4 teams will progress to SEMI FINALS. 1st v 4th & 2nd v 3rd.

Mixed

- Pool A & B – Play 5 Round, 4 Games and a bye
- Pool C – Play 4 Rounds, each team once and a ballot game
- The Top team in each pool and the next best 2nd will progress to SEMI FINALS. 1st v 4th & 2nd v 3rd.

Prizes

1st Place

- Champions of each division will receive Custom Swimmers by **Budgy Smugglers** + a Cooler Bag + Cash

2nd Place

- Runners up will receive a Beach Towel + Cash
