



## NSW Senior State Championships 2020

### How the Tournament will be run.

To get the Covid Safety Plan approved we had to adhere to the NSW Health Public Order and NSW government protocols. It means in any area we had to keep the people gathering below 500. This meant we had to make it a NO SPECTATOR tournament.

1. The tournament venue has been divided into 5 Zones. (see map)
2. The tournament will run over two time slots, A.M. & P.M. There will be a one & a half hour break between time slots. This is a mandatory break to vacate the venue before the P.M. slot.
3. Age divisions will be rostered to a zone and time slot.
4. Teams, in most instances, will play 3 games Friday & 3 on Saturday, in a game on game off format.
5. Teams are to arrive dressed ready to play & not arrive any more than 45 minutes before there kick-off.
6. Teams are to leave asap after their last game with a 30 minute limit to do so.
7. Teams need to park their cars in the areas close to their zone.
8. Teams are to go straight to their Zone and field they play their first game on.
9. Teams are allowed 3 officials with them, eg coach, assist & manager.
10. Players & Officials cannot move between zones.
11. Association licence holders can apply for an all zone access pass.
12. Zones will be policed by ground officials to adhere to the policy of '**no moving between zones.**' Please adhere to this request.
13. Persons wishing to cross zones, eg. Licence area holders, coach/player etc can apply for an all access pass. Details on how to do this will be forthcoming.



14. Massage, strapping, First Aid, Food & amenities will be available in all zones.
15. Sunday, finals day we may move all divisions to zone 1 & 2 as we will have less teams/players re gathering.
16. OES will be available for the purchase of merchandise. Location & logistics TBC.
17. It is very important we adhere to the Covid 19 Safety Plan.
18. We will be monitored by Police and other officials. Any breach may result in penalties or tournament shutdown.
19. It's imperative we adhere to the **NO Spectators** and **No moving across zones** during the round games.
20. Sunday finals will be reviewed re teams hanging around to watch later games.
21. Covid Officials will be allocated to each zone.
22. Registration sheets are to be signed by the manager & coach before handing in.
23. Managers must hand in their rego to a staff member in their zone. The staff member will be wearing an orange vest located in the middle of your zone. This must be done before your first game.
24. The rego sheet must be filled in completely as this is now part of our Covid Safety Plan tracing protocol.
